

Rules & Regulation

Student once admitted will have to observe the institutional discipline and spirit.

Regular and punctual attendance in all class activities like lecturers, demonstrations, practical, clinical teachings, tutorial test etc. as well as in all activities like: Clinical Meeting, Conferences, Guest Lecturers, Seminars as well as sports cultural etc. is Compulsory. No student shall be allowed to appear in the annual examination of the concerned subjects if her attendance falls short of 75% of the total theories.

- 1 Appearing of a student in all regular examination is compulsory. Students, Whose conduct & academic standard are not considered satisfactory, shall not be allowed to appear in the board examination.
- 2 Leave application for not attending any class with valid reason shall be submitted to the concerned class Teacher/Principal.
- 3 Mass representations of any kind including strikes, raising slogans, pasting posters etc. will attract the strictest disciplinary action.
- 4 Students should participate and take initiative for leadership in professional and activities.
- 5 No students are allowed to appear in any other exam/course during duration of course.
- 6 Pasting of poster/notice within institution without prior permission from the office of the principal is not allowed. Students are forbidden to communicate with any outside authority directly. All such communications must be submitted through the principal who will forward these If considered desirable. Student breaking the rule will be suspended.
- 7 All powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action are vested with the principal.
- 8 Without prejudice to the generality of power to enforce discipline under the ordinance, the following shall amount to act of gross indiscipline :
- 9 Physical assault, threat or use of physical force against any member of the teaching & non teaching staff of institution and against any student. Possession of fire arms, any lethal weapon, liquor/drug. Any violation of the provisions of civil rights protection act 1976.
- 10 If a student fails to take examination for one reason or the other, the institute will not entertain any claim for the refund of the fee.
- 11 The principal /director reserves the right to change the time table at any time.
- 12 Leave applications are to be recommended through the class incharge and the parents /guardians should sign the application.
- 13 Regular and punctual attendance is compulsory for class. Demonstrations, practicals, clinics, hospitals day and night. 75% attendance is essential to be eligible to appear in the examination.

Note:

If the candidate leave her/his training course in between or need any original document, she/he has to deposit the admission fee for the remaining period.

Institute will not have any kind of responsibility for any student while going to hospital/field duty or while going and coming back from home.
